




Dear OLGC Family,



On behalf of the group, I am pleased to share with you a couple of updates on the Fil/Am Community Ministry.

- We just got news that our scholar, Leobert Francisco who got his undergraduate degree in Secondary Education in 2019, passed the Board of Licensure for Teachers in 2020 (PIs see attached)
- At present, we have 4 scholars - 3 of them aiming for their undergraduate degrees in Secondary Education and 1 is pursuing her undergraduate degree in Accountancy. All 4, God willing, will graduate in 2023 (Schedule attached)
- The above are all a part of our flagship Scholarship Program under the Youth Servant Leadership Education Program (YSLEP) of Caritas Manila (Certificate of Recognition attached)
- We are now collaborating with SVDP to help a family with their utility bills. This is under our newly-launched program - KIN (Kababayan In Need) - "Kababayan" translated into "Compatriot" in English. Along the same initiative, we have helped 3 families in the past meet their needs, also in collaboration with SVDP
- We've had some changes in our Organization Chart as shown on the attached; our registration status with the State of Richmond as a charitable organization remains current

ADULT ABUSE PREVENTION – In the Commonwealth of Virginia, the month of May is Adult Abuse Prevention Month. Even though we're on the other side of last month, it's never too late to focus on something nobody wants to think about. While acknowledging that many older adults lead healthy, happy lives, we recognize that vulnerable older adults need protection from abuse, neglect, and exploitation.

During the last state fiscal year, 39,185 reports of abuse, neglect, and exploitation were received across the commonwealth. Imagine that! Fairfax County's Adult Protective Services (APS) received the greatest number of reports among all 120 local departments of social services (3,102 reports, representing 8% of the commonwealth's total reports). Self-neglect is the most common type of maltreatment experienced in Virginia at 56%, followed by Neglect by Others (17%), Financial Exploitation (13%), and Physical Abuse (6%).

A wide variety of protective services are offered to older and vulnerable adults who have been determined by APS workers to need them following investigations of reports. APS workers may arrange for various health, housing, social and legal services to stop the maltreatment and prevent further maltreatment. Services may also be arranged for individuals in emergency situations who lack the capacity to consent to services.

In Virginia, an APS report can be made by anyone who suspects that an adult aged 60 or older or an incapacitated person aged 18-59 is being abused, neglected, or exploited. Reports can be made to Fairfax County's Department of Family Services' APS hotline, 703-324-7450, or to the 24-hour toll-free Virginia APS Hotline, 1-888-832-3858.

SERVICES FOR OLDER ADULTS – Fairfax County's Department of Family Services provides many services for older adults. Since some of you probably are unaware of them, Here's a list of what's available: Adult Day Health Care Centers, Adult Protective Services, Care Management/Social Work; Caregiver Support & Respite, In-Home Care, Medicare Counseling/VICAP, Meals on Wheels, Nursing & Assisted Living Facilities, Senior Centers & Recreation, Transportation, and much more! If you need any of these services, call 703-324-7948 (TTY 711), from 8 am- 4:30 pm Monday through Friday. You can also visit www.fairfaxcounty.gov/olderadults to learn more.

There are made-to-order omelets, scrambled eggs, bacon, sausage, terrific blueberry pancakes, biscuit and sausage gravy, and fresh fruit, along with juice, Mimosas for the adults, and coffee. Parking is plentiful and free, and the cost is extremely reasonable, only \$10 for adults and \$4 for children under 12. For parties over 8, please call 703-409-3564.

This is a great opportunity to be able to enjoy a night out in a convenient location, listen to some great music at no charge, sample some yummy, freshly made food from the trucks, and mingle with friends and neighbors. Friday, June 17, will be the first Chillin' on Church this summer.

NEW TRIP – Vienna Parks and Recreation is offering a tour of Manassas Battlefield on June 29 from 8:30 am- 2:30 pm. A National Parks Service ranger will provide a thorough overview of the First Manassas campaign and battle with emphasis on the action on Henry Hill during that day.
