

AP Chemistry

Mr. Albrecht has already given the assignment packet to students who attended the AP Chemistry course meeting.

The first assignment aims to give the AP students a head start on the nomenclature that they will need to know for the class. AP Chemistry moves fast and memorizing the common ions helps students keep up.

The purpose of the second assignment is for students to review significant figures. Significant figures were previously introduced in chemistry class, but it is taught as a “side note” and not really used very much. In AP Chemistry, students need to keep track of significant figures in all labs, tests, and quizzes they do. On the AP test itself, students are expected to use and round numbers to the correct number of significant figures.

AP Chemistry summer work is due the first day of class, late work is accepted, but at a penalty. There is a 10% penalty per week on late work.
