



2021-2022 TOTS and All Aboard School Delays and Cancellations

<u>TOTS</u> and All Aboard School Delays and/or Early Dismissals: TOTS and All Aboard will be open in their designated buildings from <u>7:15 AM to 5:30 PM</u>, when there is a two-hour delay. All Aboard Readiness students may attend from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday.

- If before 7:00 AM a two hour delay changes to a cancellation, we will follow TOTS and All Aboard closure procedures listed below*.
- If after 7:00 AM a two hour delay changes to a cancellation, Preschool and All Aboard will be open at all sites from <u>7:15 AM to 5:30 PM</u> and infants and toddlers will be open at all sites from <u>7:15 AM to 11:30 AM</u>.

*TOTS and All Aboard ELearning Day Closures: When school is closed due to inclement weather or for circumstances beyond the school district's control, care is available from 7:15 AM to 5:30 PM for full time TOTS preschool and full time All Aboard families ONLY. Infants and toddler care will be open from 8:00 to 11:30 AM. Care is NOT available for All Aboard Readiness families. Below is where your child will attend on these days:

- Washington Woods Elementary (Contact Phone 317-867-7950, Mrs. Victor's room)
 TOTS Preschool and All Aboard Pre-k students who normally attend Washington Woods
 Elementary or Monon Trail Elementary will report to Washington Woods Elementary.
 Send a non-perishable lunch and drink with your child. A prepackaged breakfast and a
 PM snack will be provided. These days are included in your regular fees.
- <u>Oak Trace Elementary</u> (Contact Phone 317-867-6451, Mrs. Veatch's room) TOTS Preschool and All Aboard Pre-k students who normally attend Oak Trace Elementary or Maple Glen Elementary will report to Oak Trace Elementary. Send a non-perishable lunch and drink with your child. A prepackaged breakfast and a PM snack will be provided. These days are included in your regular fees.
- Monon Trail Elementary (Contact Phone 317-867-8675, Mrs. Burge's room) Infants and toddlers will report to Monon Trail Elementary. Care for infants and toddlers will be from 8:00 AM to 11:30 AM only. A prepackaged breakfast will be served but lunch will not be provided. If Monon Trail is not your child's usual location, please enter through the main entrance where you will be directed where to go. Families with toddlers who normally attend Oak Trace or Washington Woods will need to pack diapers, wipes, and a change of clothing for the day.

<u>Snow Days that are **NOT** ELearning Days</u>: Only TOTS preschool and All Aboard pre-k will be open from **7:15 AM to 5:30 PM.** The site your preschool or pre-k child will attend is determined below:

- Washington Woods Elementary (Contact Phone 317-867-7950, Mrs. Victor's room) TOTS Preschool and All Aboard Pre-k students who normally attend Washington Woods Elementary or Monon Trail Elementary will report to Washington Woods Elementary. Send a non-perishable lunch and drink with your child. A prepackaged breakfast and a PM snack will be provided. These days are included in your regular fees.
- Oak Trace Elementary (Contact Phone 317-867-6451, Mrs. Veatch's room)
 TOTS Preschool and All Aboard Pre-k students who normally attend Oak Trace
 Elementary or Maple Glen Elementary will report to Oak Trace Elementary. Send a
 non-perishable lunch and drink with your child. A prepackaged breakfast and a PM snack
 will be provided. These days are included in your regular fees.

Closings will be announced on local television, radio stations and through phone/text messages from the school district. All program sites will be closed in the event of a Hamilton County Travel Warning *or* if conditions are unsafe for families and staff *or* for circumstances beyond the school district's control.

As is the case in any child care, we do NOT provide credit or refunds for days not attended whether this day is by parent choice, due to conditions which make attendance unsafe, or for circumstances beyond the school district's control.

For infants and toddlers who do not regularly attend Monon Trail, please enter at Door #1. Don't forget to pack diapers and wipes! A staff member will be there to assist you.

IMPORTANT: If Hamilton County issues a Travel Warning **or** if conditions are unsafe for families and staff **or** for circumstances beyond the school district's control, parents will be notified that we are closing and children will need to be picked up as soon as safely possible.
