

# The Parents' Arts Society Chair's Statement April 2022

## The Programme: Michaelmas 2021 to Summer 2022

Events are advertised termly again, online only. We have noticed following the pandemic that company lead times are shorter so we may have to advertise some events half termly. We continue to offer zoom events free of charge and have no plans to change this. It has proved to be extremely popular with our membership. We have also reduced the number of events being offered. Events in the Michaelmas term did not sell as well as we had hoped, we felt our membership was reluctant to venture back into London particularly so we tailored our Lent term events accordingly and had a positive response.

Summer Ball (Saturday 25 June 2022) preparations are well underway. We are expecting 490 parents and staff.

### **Finances:**

We have £166,000 in both accounts but this includes £58,000 Ball tickets. We are hoping to break even on the Ball.

## Membership

Past Parents still make up the majority of our event attendees (47%) with current parents making up 37%.
