Crops by Kids

We have been planting seeds and seedlings during May and early June. This early heat wave may impact some of the crops that enjoy cooler weather. Time will tell!



Please feel free to stop by the garden this summer to pick the vegetables, enjoy a picnic in the garden, see what is growing or just look around. We will have garden map, displayed in the kiosk right outside the garden, about what vegetables are in which bed.

The annual notice was sent to families to sign up to water and weed the garden during the summer. If you haven't had the chance to send a reply, you still have time. Let me know and I can send another one if you didn't receive the first notice. The first notice was sent electronically. We haven't had our usual, large response.

According to Jerry Baker, author of Supermarket, Super Gardens, regular table salt has many purposes. One way to rid the crops such as broccoli and cabbage of those little green worms that nestle in the plant, is to place the freshly harvested crops in a large bowl of water and add a couple of teaspoons of salt in to the water. The worms will float to the surface quickly

A non-toxic weed killer for areas such as your driveway can be hand made by combining 1 quart of water, 5-6 tablespoons of white vinegar and 2-3 tablespoons of salt. Boil the water, then stir in vinegar and salt. While the mixture is still hot, pour it directly on the weeds. Be sure to keep this away from plants you want to save or this mix will kill them too. It is a good idea to do this when there is no rain in the forecast.


