NUT FREE SCHOOL

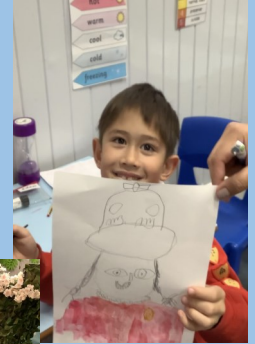
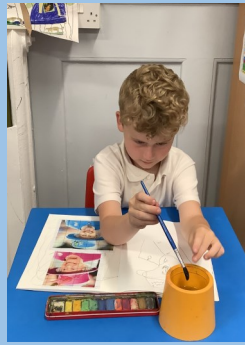
