Please label these items with student's first and last name:

- 4 Low odor Expo markers
- 8 Elmer's glue sticks
- 4 Wide-lined single subject spiral notebooks
- 1 package of wide-lined loose leaf paper
- 1 Box of 24 crayons only
- 1 Package of gel pens
- 1 Package of highlighters
- 1 half inch (½") 3-ring binder
- 1 Red two-pocket folder
- 1 Yellow two-pocket folder
- 1 Blue two-pocket folder
- 1 Green heavy-duty take home folder
- 1 Pair of scissors (pointed and good quality, such as Fiskars)
- 48 #2 pencils with erasers to share (plain, **sharpened**)
- 1 Box wide-tip markers
