Dear Parent/Guardian:

When it becomes necessary to close our schools or delay the opening of them due to hazardous weather or other emergencies, notification of such will be made via Cable TV Channel 22, News 12 New Jersey, Facebook, Twitter, BlackboardConnect phone calls and emails, as well as our website at www.sayrevillek12.net. Since we will be utilizing the aforementioned BlackboardConnect emergency alert system to make these phone call, email, and text message announcements, please make sure that you provide your school with your current phone numbers and email addresses and be sure to notify the main office of the school of any changes during the course of the school year. Finally, please do not call the individual schools to check for school closings. These lines need to remain open for emergency purposes.

If there is an early dismissal, please make arrangements to pick up your child from school if they are a "walker" or have someone meet your child at the bus stop if that is how you have designated that they go home. In addition, please remember that when there is an early dismissal, BASC will be cancelled and that all students in the program will be sent home in accordance with how they were designated by you to be sent (walker or busser). Finally, it is strongly recommended that children be instructed prior to an emergency or school closing where to go and what to do in the event that someone is not home. This is particularly true for working parents.

Please note that if an early dismissal is scheduled for a day in which a delayed opening is called, the **early dismissal will be cancelled,** along with **all evening events**, which as a result, will more than likely be rescheduled.
