



Montpelier School Full Online Expectations for Grades KK-2



Students/Parents

- It is the student/family's responsibility to check Schoology daily and to be aware of required Zoom meetings, video recordings and dates of assignments. This may include physical assignments and the pick-up/drop off dates of assignments.
- Grading will be more rigorous and attendance to Zoom meetings or video recordings is required.

Grades

- Students will be graded with percentages for Language Arts and Math in grades 1-2.
- Students will receive Pass/Fail grades for Science and Social Studies in grades 1-2.
- Late work may be accepted depending on the teacher's individual policy. Individual teacher policy will be posted on Schoology and communicated with the students and parents.

Related Arts/Specials

- All related arts classes will be pass/fail.
- Teachers are not required to hold Zoom meetings.
- Teachers will post assignments one week in advance on Schoology.

Posting of Assignments and Lessons

- All teachers will post assignments one week in advance on Schoology.
- Teachers will design recorded video lessons, no less than two times a week.

Zoom Meetings

- Teachers will do no less than two live Zoom meetings per class each week. Time of the sessions will be at the discretion of the teacher. This will be used to instruct or review skills. Science and Social Studies may be integrated in the ELA Zoom meetings.
- Zoom meetings will be determined by the teacher in advance with a set consistent schedule.
- Zoom meetings may be offered with potential awards given for attendance. This will be determined by the individual teacher. If a student cannot attend a required Zoom meeting or live instruction, completion of assignments on time, may be approved for attendance.
- Video recordings may be supplemented in place of live Zoom meetings that cannot be attended.
- Points should not be lost for failure to attend a Zoom meeting.

Feedback and Grading

- Teachers are required to answer student and parent questions within 24 business hours.
- Teachers will have assignments/tests graded within 1 week of completion. Exceptions will be made when using traditional mail.
- Teachers are encouraged but not required to deliver paper packets to families each week (porch drop off) or mail/pick-up/drop off.
- Teachers will have daily office hours posted for assistance if needed or requested by families.
