



Montpelier School Full Online Expectations for Grades 3-6



Students/Parents

- It is the student's/family's responsibility to check Schoology daily and to be aware of required Zoom meetings, video recordings, and dates of assignments. This may include physical assignment and the pick-up/drop off dates of assignments.
- Grading will be more rigorous and attendance to Zoom meetings is mandatory.

Grades

- All academic classes will have a letter grade consistent with the grade card. This includes math, language arts, science and social studies.
- Late work may or may not be accepted depending on the individual teacher's policy. Individual teacher policy will be posted on Schoology and communicated with the students and parents.
- Plagiarism and/or cheating will result in an automatic 0%.

Related Arts/Specials

- All related arts classes will be pass/fail.
- Teachers are not required to hold Zoom meetings.
- Teachers will post assignments a week in advance on Schoology.

Posting of Assignments

- All teachers will post assignments one week in advance on Schoology.
- Teachers will design recorded video lessons, no less than two times a week.

Zoom Meetings

- English Language Arts and Math Zoom meetings will be held a minimum of **twice a week** per subject/per class for no less than **30 minutes**. Social studies and Science Zoom meetings may be held at a minimum of once a week for no less than **30 minutes**.
- Zoom meetings will be determined by the teacher in advance with a set consistent schedule.
- Zoom meetings may be required with participation points and/or awards given for attendance. This will be determined by the individual teacher. If a student cannot attend a required Zoom meeting or live instruction, completion of assignments on time, may be approved without the loss of points.
- Video recordings may be supplemented in place of live Zoom meetings that cannot be attended.
- Teachers will allow for a "make-up" Zoom meeting in case a student cannot attend one during the week. This may be an extra Zoom session or the allowance of students to join another class.

Feedback and Grading

- Teachers are required to answer student and parent questions within 24 business hours.
- Teachers will have assignments/tests graded 1 week of completion. Exceptions will be made when using traditional mail.
- Teachers are encouraged but not required to deliver paper packets to families each week (porch drop off) or mail/pick-up/drop off.
- Teachers will have daily office hours posted for assistance if needed or requested.
