**Montpelier Exempted Village BOE Alternatives to Quarantine Students October 12, 2021-More options to the Traditional Quarantine. (Trial Basis Starting October 13, 2021, Revised 1/14/22) Positive Covid Case Confirmed (Health Department-Confirmed)**

**Parents and students are responsible for symptom monitoring; however, if nurses/school staff see a student exhibiting symptoms they should act accordingly.**

**Contact Tracing Performed (Close Contacts)**

Anyone identified as close contact in the tracing fall under the following options:

- 1) **Mandatory mask quarantine** *A student who is symptom free will be permitted to continue in person learning provided they do the following:*
  - *Wear a properly fitted face covering for ten (10) days while on school grounds for any reason*
  - *Perform daily self-checks to ensure they remain symptom free.*
  - *After the tenth day of being symptom free, the student may return to normal protocol of mask optional*
  - **\*Failure to comply with proper masking the student will automatically complete the remainder of quarantine at home.**
- 2) **Modified mask and testing quarantine:** *A student who is symptom free will be permitted to continue in person learning provided they do the following:*
  - A. **With PCR Test**
    - *Wear a properly fitted face covering for five (5) days while on school grounds for any reason.*
    - *On the 5<sup>th</sup> day of quarantine, have a medical doctor verified negative PCR test results.*
    - *Upon a verified negative test, student may return to normal school protocol.*
  - B. **With Vaccination**
    - *Individuals, who are symptom free and can verify fully vaccination status, can continue in person learning if wearing a properly fitted face covering for 10 days. (Be mindful of HB 244 and inability to discriminate effective October 13, 2021)*
  - C. **With Anti-Body Test**
    - *Individuals with a Doctor verified anti-body test within 90 days of current quarantine date can continue in person learning while wearing a properly fitted face covering for 10 days.*
      - ***\*Any student determined to be a close contact, and was wearing a properly fitted face covering will not be required to quarantine.***

### **Covid 19 Positive**

*If you have tested positive for COVID-19, stay home and separate yourself from others. You can end isolation when ALL of the following are met:*

#### *If you have symptoms*

- 1. It has been at least 5 days since symptoms first started*
- 2. It has been at least 24 hours without any active symptoms (fever, vomiting, diarrhea, and no use of medications to control symptoms)*
- 3. Your symptoms have improved*
- 4. Continue to wear a mask for 5 additional days after returning to normal activities*

#### *If you have no symptoms*

- 1. It has been at least 5 days since you took a covid test*
- 2. Continue to wear a mask for 5 additional days after returning to normal activities*

### **Extracurriculars**

*Please follow guidelines listed above and remove mask only when actively participating in the event.*
