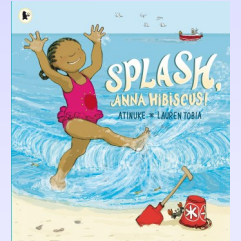




Dear Parents and Carers 6.6.22

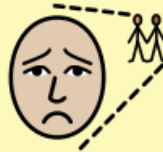
In maths we will continue exploring doubling. We will be generating our own doubling problems and recording these in number sentences. We will explore the concept of 'greater than'.



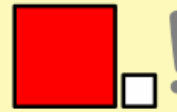

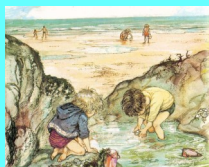
