

Seeking Applicants for Measure “B” Citizens' Oversight Committee

The Buena Park School District (BPSD) proudly serves the communities of Buena Park, La Palma, Fullerton, Anaheim and unincorporated areas of North Orange County to provide educational programs to 4,100 transitional kindergarten through eighth grade students at our eight schools. On June 3, 2014, our community supported Measure “B” and the issuance of \$71 million in general obligation bonds to repair and upgrade our classrooms and schools.

Over the past six years, we have modernized all eight schools, completed seismic upgrades at two other schools, installed campus wide Wi-Fi districtwide, converted all playground surfaces to rubberized surfaces, and issued iPads for all students Grades 4-8, and currently completing a performing arts building at Buena Park Middle School. Projects planned in 2021 and beyond include the modernization of the school site multipurpose rooms, modernize Pendleton Elementary School front office and multi-purpose room, build a new locker room at Beatty Middle School, and new marquees at Pendleton Elementary and Beatty Middle School.

The District is currently seeking applicants for an independent citizens’ oversight committee to oversee bond proceeds & expenditures, review audit reports, and ensure spending consistent with Measure “B” guidelines. Committee members cannot be an employee or official of the school district or a current vendor. The California Education Code requires that the Committee have at least one member representing each of the following categories:

- Active member of a taxpayers’ organization
- Active member of a Business organization representing business community
- Active member of a Senior citizens' organization
- A parent or guardian of a current BPSD student
- A member of our PTA, school site council, or other school organization

Committee members must reside within our school district boundaries.
