UNIFORM EXPECTATIONS


Children are expected to be in full uniform, including a tie.

Welcome back to school. We hope you have had a lovely half term, ready for our final term of the year!

In Destination Reader we will be reading *The Miraculous Adventures of Edward Tulane* by Kate DiCamillo. This text is about a china rabbit who once belonged to a little girl.



In English during term 5 we will be learning poetry and an explanation text. Children will learn to internalise a text, then innovate it and then write their own.

In Maths we will continue to learn how to tell the time, before moving on to properties of shapes and mass and capacity.

In Geography we will be looking at, and comparing the different climate zones around the world.

In D.T we will be looking at how linkages work and designing our own moving toy.

In Better Brains we will be learning about 'Speakup4better' and how 'Prep4Best' can help with our needs.

In Science we will be learning about light and shadows. In Computing we will be looking at coding, word processing and combined publishing. In R.E we will be learning about Christianity.

Home Learning
