Who can be a partner?

Any organization (government, nonprofit, business, faith-based organization, higher education institution, community group) that shares one or more goals with the district and that supports the district's overall values and strategic objectives.

What is an "approved partner"?

An approved partner is an organization that has a current, signed MOU or contract with BVSD. The activities approved to occur within BVSD are those that are specified in the contract or MOU, as are any commitments by BVSD to the partner organization. A list of approved partners with links to contracts and MOUs will be provided to schools and departments to inform their work.







Community Partner Defined

BVSD defines a community partner as an outside organization (local, national or global) that collaborates with us on activities that support shared goals and require coordination of efforts and resources by both BVSD and the partner.

What kinds of activities can partners engage in with us?

BVSD is interested in working with partners in a variety of ways that include, but are not limited to:

- providing free or heavily subsidized services to students, families and or staff
- organizing, participating in or sponsoring events that benefit students, families and or staff
- advising on the design and implementation of district initiatives at the request of the district, or as specified in an MOU or other formal agreement
- providing resources or volunteers to support district activities
- collaborating on multi agency initiatives that are seeking to solve community level issues (emergency response work-force development, health and human services, social justice, sustainability, etc.)
