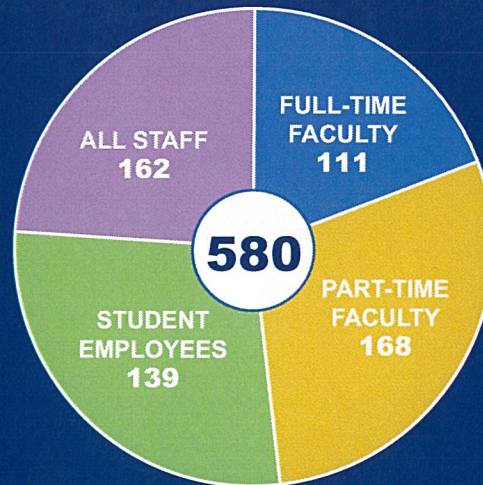

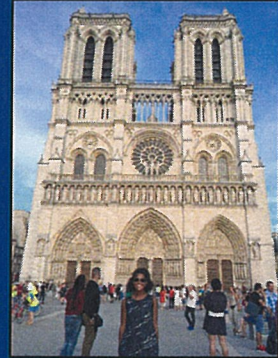
- 34 English Immersion Program students for Fall 2018

ECONOMIC IMPACT



Stark County Impacts

- **\$381.7 million in total economic impact to Stark County**
 - 590 Kent State employees (all campuses) reside in Stark County
 - 11,433 working alumni = \$290.5 million in earnings
- Nearly \$42.6 million in total labor income
- \$91.2 million of economic output
- \$4 million in state and local taxes
