Please include the student's name and your name so I can give the picture to the student at the beginning of the year.
- 4. Along with a picture, please share some fun details about Flat Stanley's adventure with you! We would love to know what he/she has been doing, and we would love to learn some interesting facts about the place/area/state you live. We've included a sheet for you to write a few fun facts about your adventure with Flat Stanley.
- 5. After a fun-filled visit, please pack Flat Stanley safely back inside an envelope and mail him/her back to the student or to the next friend/family member on the list, as instructed by the student.

IMPORTANT: Whoever has Flat Stanley on July 20, 2022, is asked to PLEASE pack him/her up and send him back home, along with anything he/she has collected along the way. The class is eager to see where Flat Stanley has traveled over the summer! Please follow through with this so that Flat Stanley's maker is not disappointed. We appreciate your effort and your contribution to education!
