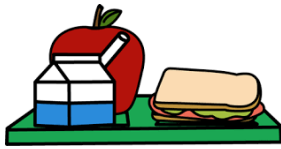


IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO NOTE

Free and Reduced Meal Application



The USDA free meal waivers expire on June 30, 2022. As a result, meals for the 2022-2023 school year will be charged accordingly based on students' Free, Reduced, and Paid meal status. Even though meals are free through June 30 of this school year, we strongly encourage all families who might be eligible for free and reduced meal benefits to submit an application now. Filling out an application now may qualify families to receive seamless meal benefits through October 15 to start the new school year. Completing an application online through [Myschoolapps](#) takes less than 10 minutes, and parents only need to complete one application per family.
