Policy Title: Board Vacancies

A vacancy shall be declared by the Board of Trustees when any nominee has been elected but has failed to qualify for office, or when any trustee shall (a) die; (b) resign as trustee; (c) remove him(her)self from his/her trustee zone of residence; (d) no longer be a resident or school district elector of the district; (e) refuse to serve as a trustee; or (f) without excuse acceptable to the Board of Trustees, fail to attend four (4) consecutive regular meetings of the Board.

Declaration of vacancy shall be made at any regular or special meeting of the Board of Trustees.

The Board of Trustees shall appoint to such vacancy a person qualified to serve as a trustee. In the event the Board of Trustees is unable to appoint a trustee from the zone vacated after ninety (90) days, the Board of Trustees may appoint a person-at-large from within the boundaries of the school district to serve as trustee for the zone where the vacancy occurred. After 120 days from the declaration of vacancy, appointments shall be made by the Board of County Commissioners if the Board of Trustees has been unable to fill the vacancy.

Any person appointed shall serve the unexpired term of the office which was declared vacant and filled by appointment.
