Policy Title: Responsibilities

The main responsibilities of the Board are to:

1. Employ the chief executive officer and support him/her in his/her duties.
2. Discuss and act upon a) the annual budget, b) recommendation for capital outlay, c) nominations for principals and teachers, d) the extension or readjustment of the educational programs, e) the course of study and adoption of textbooks.
3. Require and consider reports concerning the business transacted, financial status, progress of the schools, achievement of students, and performance of teachers, supervisors and administrators.
4. Represent the schools and their needs before the patrons and the electors.
5. Act as a court of final appeals for students, teachers and patrons; hear petitions.
6. Visit the schools to acquaint themselves with the effectiveness of instruction and the needs of the pupils and schools.
7. Conduct an annual performance review of the superintendent of schools.
8. Conduct an annual Board self-assessment.

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
