Policy Title: Home Bound Student

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It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to provide instruction for regularly enrolled students who may be confined to home and/or hospital.

A home instruction student is defined as being a student enrolled in the Post Falls School District who would normally and regularly attend school, but is unable to for medical reasons. Post Falls School District provides short-term home instruction for students when needed. The student must have a medical condition that will result in an absence from school for ten (10) or more consecutive days. Consideration will be given for home instruction that does not meet the ten (10) consecutive days only when the medical conditions of the student warrants.

The request for home instruction must be made in writing by the parent or guardian. A statement from the family physician, including a diagnosis, physical limitations and anticipated duration for home instruction is required to be on file.

Requests for home instruction will be processed by the administrator/counselor in each building and forwarded to the District Administrative Office.
