Policy Title: Compulsory Attendance

Parents or guardians are required to have children ages seven (7) through sixteen (16) enrolled in and attending a public, private, or parochial school. This school must meet the certification and standard requirements of the State of Idaho, per Idaho Code § 33-202 through 205.

Whenever it is determined by the Board or the Board's designee under the provisions of due process of law that the parents/guardians of any child who is not enrolled in the public schools are failing to meet the requirements of Idaho Code § 33-202, an authorized representative of the Board shall notify in writing the prosecuting attorney in the county of the pupil's residence and recommend that a petition shall be filed in the magistrate division of the District court of the county of the pupil's residence in such form as the court may require under provisions of Idaho Code § 20-510.
