Policy Title: Foreign Exchange Students

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The Board, administration and staff believe there are benefits to students, schools and the community when foreign students are allowed to attend high school in the United States. In order to make their visits profitable and enjoyable to themselves and to other students, staff and the community, these students will be permitted to enroll in the Post Falls School District. The administration will provide rules and regulations governing foreign students.

All foreign students will be required to follow all of the rules, regulations and policies of the district and pay the same fees required of resident students.

The Post Falls School District reserves the right to deny admittance to any foreign student or exchange student program sponsors.

A foreign exchange student is defined as a student from a foreign country studying in the United States under the sponsorship of an exchange organization. Approval will be made only for those students who are sponsored by exchange organizations which have Teenager Exchange Visitor Programs designation as listed by the United States International Agency and/or the Council on Standards for International Education Travel. The organization must have a local sponsor and follow foreign exchange procedures.
