Policy Title: Truancy

It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to look upon the act of truancy as unacceptable conduct. A student who is absent from school without parental permission and/or knowledge, or who reports to school and then leaves without first receiving permission to leave by a school authority is regarded as truant.

An habitual truant is any student who, in the judgment of the Board of Trustees, repeatedly has violated the attendance regulations established by the Board or any child whose parent or guardian has failed or refused to cause such child to be instructed as required by Idaho Code 33-202 may be directly proceeded against pursuant Idaho Code 33-207 and corollary sections of the Idaho Code.
