Policy Title: Sex Offender Prohibition

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The Board of Trustees directs the administration to prohibit registered sex offenders from entrance to school premises.

To protect the health and safety of students, the Post Falls School District denies registered adult sex offenders entrance onto the premises of any district school. District officials will make a good faith effort to identify registered sex offenders by screening volunteers/visitors who seek entrance onto school property during times that school is in session.

Registered sex offenders who are parents or guardians of a student attending a school within the district, and whose right to educational information or access to his/her child or ward has not been limited by court order, may be granted a waiver to this prohibition by the superintendent and/or his/her designee. The waiver may include strict conditions regarding the entrance of said registered sex offender. The waiver may be revoked at any time by the superintendent and/or his/her designee. Registered sex offenders wishing to attend a parent/teacher conference or other school event, drop off and pick children up or make a mail, food or other delivery must contact the district office annually and prior to the first visit of the school year requesting to be on school grounds.
