Policy No. 507.1

Policy Title: Fraternities or Sororities

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It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to prohibit any person, group or organization from establishing a fraternity, sorority or other secret society whose membership is comprised in whole or in part of pupils enrolled in the public elementary or secondary school of the Post Falls School District, or to solicit a pupil in any such school to become a member of such organization.

For the purpose of this policy a fraternity, sorority or secret society shall be interpreted as any organization the active membership of which is comprised in whole or in part of pupils enrolled in the public elementary or secondary schools and which exists or perpetuates itself wholly or partly by selecting members on the basis of the decision of its membership (voting on who becomes a member) rather than upon the basis of the right of any pupil, qualified by the rules and regulations of the school, to be a member. The definition shall not include organizations institutionally sponsored by agencies of public welfare, such as the Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, Campfire Girls, The YMCA, YWCA, 4-H and similar organizations.
