Procedure Title: Activities

Section Title: Extra-Curricular Activities

Sub-Section No. 507.6a

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1. ALL EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES (INCLUDING ATHLETICS)
 - A. All extra-curricular activities that require the use of district transportation shall be subject to the availability of school buses, fuel and funds.
 - B. All extra-curricular activities will be restricted that require the employment of substitute teachers for advisors or coaches. The amount of time that students are away from the instructional program will be kept to a minimum.
 - C. During school closure because of weather conditions, all activities, other than varsity, are to be closed for that period of time. The superintendent or his/her designee will make a thorough check of all conditions and weather before a varsity activity can be held.
 - D. If schools are closed because of health problems, activities are to be suspended for all levels until school again resumes. This also applies to school sponsored activities on weekends.
 - E. Each principal shall submit a copy of the activities calendar to the central office prior to the start of each semester.
 - F. Any student who transfers to or enrolls in Post Falls School District, either as a full-time student or as a dual enrolled student, who has been suspended from or denied participation in extra-curricular activities in his/her previous school (whether private, charter or public) shall be subject to the same suspension/denial in Post Falls School District. Failure of the student, or the student's parents/guardians to disclose such suspension/denial from the previous school shall constitute grounds to deny any participation in extra-curricular activities while enrolled in Post Falls School District.
 - G. Participation in extra-curricular activities by any student shall be subject to the execution by the student and his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) of a Participation Contract in substance and as approved by the Administration.
2. ATHLETIC COMPETITION
 - A. Athletic competition with other school districts shall be restricted to students in grades 7-12. The athletic director shall be responsible for all athletic activities, and shall evaluate coaches and programs. Reports and recommendations shall be made to the building principal. No changes in established schedules may be made without express permission of the athletic director.
 - B. No student shall be permitted to compete in organized non-school competition after the starting date of the high school season in that sport. If a student is participating in a youth athletic sport team, he/she may not be permitted to participate on a school team in the same sport.
