BRING TO TRYOUTS

Athletic clearance account- https://www.homecampus.com/login is where you will need to log in to create an account.

Sports Physical- All players must have a current sports physical either uploaded to their athletic clearance account (Home Campus)or bring it with them to tryouts. (need to use Oxnard union physical form)

Covid consent waiver form- ALL players must sign and turn this in on the day of tryouts. All the above information about athletic clearance, as well as forms you can print out are on my website; www.riomesahoops.wordpress.com You will need to look under forms on the website.

Some things to keep in mind if your child makes a team.

Summer; practice will be a couple times a week. No practice for sure during June 22-July 5. This is the CIF dead weeks for all athletes.

Commitment- During the regular season; We have practices 5-6 days a week, usually 2 hrs or longer (could be before or after school) Practices are mandatory

Academics- players must maintain at least a 2. 0 GPA in order to play sports.
