Dear Parent/Guardian of a Class of 2022 Student,

Congratulations! The Princeton High School faculty, staff, and administrative team are pleased to recognize and honor the indomitable PHS Class of 2022. Having demonstrated persistence despite myriad challenges, the Class of 2022 is in the final stretch of its PHS journey. This year, PHS has gradually been returning to some of the beautiful traditions that make our school such a special place. One tradition that we are happy to announce is the return of graduation to the front lawn of the Princeton High School campus. The Class of 2022 Commencement will be held on the front lawn in proximity to our beloved tower beginning at 5:30 pm on Monday, June 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

Seating will be arranged to provide priority seating for four (4) family members. Additional open seating can be found in the bleachers that will be arranged on the perimeter of the lawn. Enclosed with this letter are (4) FAMILY PHS graduation wristbands. These will serve as the "ticket".

When there was inclement weather in previous years, we moved the ceremony indoors and provided priority seating in Tiger Gymnasium (a.k.a. New Gym) for two family members per graduate. We are not planning to move the ceremony indoors this year in abundance of caution with placing a large gathering of people in one indoor location. Should we experience inclement weather earlier on graduation day, then we will move the commencement back by one hour to 6:30 pm hoping that the weather improves. However, should the weather not improve that day, then we will reschedule the ceremony to the following day, Tuesday, June 21<sup>st</sup> at 10:00 am on the front lawn. We will make an initial call regarding the start time of graduation by noon of June 20<sup>th</sup>.

Families and guests attending graduation may park in the PHS parking lots on Walnut Lane and Houghton Road as well as neighboring streets. Please respect our neighbors by parking carefully, not blocking any driveways, or obstructing side streets. As you are able, please consider carpooling. If you have handicap needs, please call the PHS main office for instructions.

I am enclosing graduation announcements with envelopes. We hope you will be able to send these to family and friends, who will share your pride in your graduate. If you need more, please call the main office; we have a limited number available. Enclosed with this letter, the wristbands, and announcement are other important documents relating to this monumental event.

This will be an evening we remember with joy as we honor our graduates near our Tower basking in the illustrious history of our school. With enthusiastic anticipation, we look forward to celebrating the Princeton High School Class of 2022 with you.
