

## ClassLink for Elementary Students


ClassLink is a dashboard that reduces logins and provides access for students in grades K-12 to the applications and programs that support classroom instruction both at home and in school.


Once signed in, you will land on the dashboard of icons that will host your specific applications and programs for learning.



**Teachers and students will have the following applications available on ClassLink to start the school year:**



Choose Schoology to open up our Learning Management System where you will find the courses you are enrolled in on your student specific home page. Schoology will provide access to course content, class assignments, discussion boards, videos, assessments and more. (K-12)




Choose Microsoft Office 365 to launch a variety of tools that can be used for collaboration, presentation and publication. These products include: Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Teams, OneNote, ClassNotebook, Sway and Stream. Students will need to use their Microsoft credentials to log in. (K-12)



Choose Google to access a variety of Google productivity tools that can be used in the classroom including Google Drive, Google Docs, Google Slides and more. (K-12)

### Instructional Programs



Choose BrainPOP to engage in short animated movies that cover a range of content areas including science, social studies, English, math, engineering and technology, health, and arts and music. Each movie has related activities and a quiz. Teachers may use this to build background knowledge, review a topic, or to extend learning. (K-5)




Choose First in Math to engage in math games designed to strengthen fact fluency, automaticity, computational thinking and other critical skills. Teachers assign First in Math to students to provide additional practice or extension. (K-8)




Choose IXL for personalized learning and practice that supports classroom instruction. Teachers assign IXL to students to provide additional practice or extension. As students engage in lessons they are given feedback, reteaching, and an opportunity to go to mastery on skills. Teachers get real time data on student progress that can be further supported in the classroom. (K-8)



Choose Learning A-Z to access Raz Kids. Raz Kids is an online guided reading program with interactive e-books, downloadable books, and reading quizzes. (K-5)



Choose Newsela to find authentic content such as articles and text sets from the world's most trusted providers at your correct reading level. Teachers can assign Newsela articles that relate to instructional content taught in the classroom. Each text has assessment questions and writing prompts which can be used as a check for understanding. (K-12)



Choose Seesaw to document your learning. This tool enables each student to have their own journal where they can add things to it, like photos, videos, drawings, or notes. (K-5)



Choose the TCI icon while in your Science or Social Studies classes to access the interactive lessons, readings, and assignments that your teacher will use during instruction. (2-5)



Choose Wixie to create. Students can use Wixie's paint tools, text options, clip art, and voice recording to develop online storybooks and slideshows, building essential 21st century skills. (K-5)
