Day 1 Introduction to Restorative Practices

Day 1 will provide participants with the foundational understanding of Restorative Practices along with opportunities to grow skill sets to implement core restorative strategies for sustainable implementation.

Topics include: mindfulness activities, check-in and check-out, empty the cup pair/triad share, affective communication, small and large circle discussions, social discipline window, & use of restorative questions.

Day 2 Effective Use of Circles

Day 2 will provide participants with the foundational understanding and skill set of how to develop and effectively facilitate different types of restorative circles in educational settings.

Topics include: How to use circle prompts, principles of relationship building, identifying commonalities while reducing stereotyping, and identifying possible implementation challenges that may arise.
