

English

We will be reading our core text *Elephant Dance, A Journey Through India*. The children will be building on their use of descriptive language by applying this to write similes to compare one thing to another. They will be using all of the skills in writing they have learned so far to write a recount about India Day. Later in the term, we will be thinking about questions we would like to ask the teachers in Year 2.

DT

The children will be tasting a variety of fruits and then choosing their favourites to design and make a fruit kebab. They will be learning how to use knives safely. Once they have eaten their fruit kebabs, the children will evaluate their delicious kebabs.



Music

The children will be composing their own music in response to pictures and phrases from our core text *Elephant Dance*. They will be creating their own symbols to represent the instruments they use. We will also be learning to use 2sequence on Purple Mash to compose music, using technology.



Science

We will be continuing to learn about plants this term. First we will find out about deciduous and evergreen trees and how they are different to each other. We will also learn the names of many common plants that grow in the local area, including trees. We will be conducting fascinating experiments, too.

PE

The children will be linking movements together to learn dances for our Summer performance. Children will be sequencing movements together to support them to play a variety of team sports.

RE


We will be learning about creation stories from a variety of different faiths and world views. We will be comparing these stories and talking about the things we find interesting or puzzling about them.

Maths

We will be continuing to count, read and write numbers to 100 in numerals, partitioning into tens and ones. We will learn more about how to read and write each number too.
