

We will be incorporating this into our role play, going on virtual zoo tours and trips to the beach, thinking about the different weather we may encounter and what we may need to take on our journey.



Reminder

Please also could we ask that you bring water only for your child to drink during the day—this will help prepare them for school,, when they will be given their own water bottle to drink from.

Transition

Many of our pre-schoolers will be moving up to the school in September. There will be opportunities for children and parents to meet the teachers before this transition.

In the nursery we will be helping your children get ready for the move up by taking them to visit their reception classrooms and nearer the end of term, taking them for lunch in the hall. We will also provide social stories and extra support for those who need or ask for it.

Fortunately we are already very close to our reception classes and the children are familiar with the outdoor play area and the current teachers, but we will be there in September to support them as they begin a new chapter in their lives.

Last Term

Last term we explored the story of Cinderella and The Very Hungry Caterpillar. Children were very interested in the life cycle of bugs and we found many insects in the garden.



We also made and have put up on display a minibeast garden in the hallway, which you are welcome to pop in and see when you drop off your child. If you wish, you can also look at our floor book which has many pictures of the things we have done over the school year!
