Our Learning this term

In maths this term we will be focusing on number, specifically place value and will be working with numbers up to 100! We will be using hundred squares, will be able to partition numbers and also compare numbers.

In English, we will be writing our own recount. We will learn all about Bob the man in the moon and then write a diary entry as bob!

In History, we will be learning about seaside holidays, both past and current. In RE, we will be returning to learn more about Christianity and will be learning about the Christian Creation Story. In Computing, we will begin to explore spreadsheets and data.

We will continue to teach phonics daily phonics sessions, so please do recap sounds at home with your children.



Homework and Reading at Home!

Reading a wide variety of texts is so beneficial and supports the children in all areas of the curriculum. It improves vocabulary, improves writing skills and fosters a love of reading. The children in Year 1 read daily with an adult but it is still important that they read to you at home. We will provide an appropriate reading book, but can only issue this to your child if they have a **bookbag in school**. We aim to change reading books on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday, however please bring the book bag every day to ensure that it does get changed regularly.
