1	Will the processed aggregate base be provided by the town, or is the contractor responsible to include it as part of the square yard price? Or, will you add it to the Contingent Construction items?	This would be contingency. Most reclaiming operation require the removal of excess material. The addition of material would be if base did not meet spec.
2	Are categories per street or per mobilization.	Mobilization, some streets connect to each other.
3	Will unsuitable material be paid hourly? Material to replace BRG or process aggregate there is not an item	Unsuitable material will be trucked out under hourly. If new aggregate is need the town will purchases aggregate from one if its vendors and utilize the trucking in the bid.
4	Will the 3 rd item in each category be combined with one of the first two to find the low bidder?	Each item will be compared in the bid to find the lowest bidder.
