PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- * (1) Meet and instruct assigned classes in the locations and at the times designated.
- * (2) Encourage students to set and maintain standards of appropriate classroom behavior.
- * (3) Assess the accomplishments of students on a regular basis and provide progress reports as required or appropriate.

- (12) Assist classroom teachers, parents, and students in recognizing potential candidates for the gifted program.
- (13) Program for future success of students by teaching future skills and giving guidance for educational and vocational needs specific to needs of the Gifted students.
- (14) Be aware of unique opportunities available to gifted students and disseminate information.
- (15) Support and encourage social and affective needs of Gifted students.
- (16) Prepare required reports and maintain accurate and complete records as required by law, District policy, and administrative regulations.
- (17) Perform other incidental tasks consistent with the goals and objectives of this position.
