WHAT ABOUT WORLD LANGUAGE?

- If you are currently taking a World Language and have a B or higher, we suggest you continue with that language in 9th grade.
- If you are currently taking STEM and wish to take a language, you can take Spanish 1, French 1 or Chinese Mandarin 1 in 9th grade.
- **World Language is NOT a requirement for graduation but 2-3 years is necessary to get into some colleges.**

 - Completion of 8th Grade Social Studies

 - These courses are required for all students entering 9th grade

WORLD LANGUAGE

Prerequisite for all level II = Level I minimum grade of C

- There is a wide variety of elective classes to choose from...
 - Some courses are worth 1 credit (2MP)
