



HB 1525 & SB 9

- Based on recommendations from SHAC
- Suitable for subject & grade level
- Reviewed by academic experts in the subject and grade level
- Must cover TEKS
- Provide parents with a timeline of instruction and 14 day notification before instruction begins
- Must obtain written consent from the student's parent
