Cornelia's Camp

Ages 2 and 3 year olds
Our littlest campers will enjoy activities such as water play, yoga, imaginative dance, science, and arts and crafts. Class sizes are kept small to accommodate students. The campers also will engage in gross motor activities, free play, songs, stories and more.

Explorers Camp

Grades Pre-Kindergarten-1

Ecosystem Engineers

July 11-15

Grades 2-8

Campers will learn about endangered animals through fun interactive activities. They will then create representations of them and their habitat completely out of paper. We will use paper engineering techniques and will use the WWF origami app. The role of paper (and trees) in the preservation of endangered species will also be discussed. Full day (with half-day option).

Stop Animation

July 18-22

Grades 1-8

Explore all the steps in creating a stop animation short video. Create a storyboard, design characters and a set, shoot photo sequences, add sound using stop animation software, and edit into a finished video. Full day (with half-day option).

Full STEAM Ahead to Disney

July 25-July 29

PreK to Second Grade

Engineer solutions to some big challenges with inspiration from "A Bug's Life", craft a self-propelling boat for Moana, explore the science of ice with Elsa and more. Each day will feature STEAM activities inspired by new and classic Disney stories. Half-day only.

Minecraft/Rube Goldberg

August 1-5

Grades 2-8

The official Rube Goldberg Minecraft Challenge may be over but we can still challenge ourselves to build a Rube Goldberg contraption in Minecraft. Campers will explore the physics of Rube Goldberg machines and then work collaboratively to build and connect their designs in Minecraft. Full day (with half-day option).




