

AP Summer Work 2022

The purpose of your summer work is to prepare for the series you create in the AP course. The work you do this summer is absolutely foundational to your AP portfolio whether you use any works you make this summer or not.

It is the beginning of you considering what subjects, themes, media and techniques you wish to explore in depth - the foundation of developing your **Sustained Investigation**

A Sustained Investigation is: an inquiry and quest to answer a question about something that deeply interests or concerns you.

Here is what you will do this summer:

- **Read through this entire document fully and carefully**
 - Do NOT wait until August to begin this work
 - Email me with any questions anytime
- I. **Create a folder** on Google and **start an image flood of at least 50 photographs and artworks that inspire you.** This is best done over time, not all at once
- a. These might include:
 - i. Images of possible subject matter - so, include your own original source photos
 - ii. Images of media you want to explore
 - iii. Images of techniques you would like to explore
 - iv. Images of artworks and artists you like
- II. **Explore Your Ideas/Concepts**
- a. Many students have a basic concepts of some topic or topics they wish to investigate – but you *must expand an initial idea to go beyond the obvious*
 - b. **Make a list of at least 5 Ideas or Concepts you may want to investigate**
 - c. **Then, for each of those ideas, list at least 5-10 ways to expand on it. This includes written thoughts and/or sketches..**
 - i. **What about this makes you want to explore it through your art? Is it personal?**
 - ii. **What ways might you explore this?**
 - iii. For example, with regard to your idea are you exploring texture, mark making, light and shade, unusual composition....
- III. **Develop 3 of your 5 of ideas/concepts**
- a. **These further developments should each be from a different concept/idea**
Choose 3 ideas to develop and create an artwork for each
Each Final piece includes the following:
 - b. Description of the concept
 - c. Concept sketch
 - d. Progress images
 - i. At least 3 taken at various stages during the project
 - e. Finished Artwork

- f. Written explanation of what you learned from the process, the materials, what you enjoyed, what was frustrating and if you think this is still an idea you want to pursue.
- IV. At the beginning of the Fall Semester be prepared to submit a set of Google Slides containing the following:**
- a. **Link to Google Folder of 50 inspirational images**
 - b. **List of 5 Sustained Investigation concepts with expanded sketches/notes**
 - c. **3 Finished works that include the 5 steps listed above**

If you do this you will be glad you did, if you don't, maybe AP isn't for you.....
