
### Written and Taught Curriculum Alignment

Implemented planning from curriculum units in ELA and Math

- 55% of lesson plans reviewed included standard, objective, and end of lesson assessment (success criteria)
- 70% of teachers "comfortable" with planning from the curriculum
- 58% of teachers use the curriculum at least weekly or more to plan lessons (increase from 45% in 2021)








### **Retention and Satisfaction Ratings**





Chart 1. Over-the-year percent change in CPI-U, Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale, AZ,




#### IT Work Orders Resolved - 72 Hours




#### **SY2022 IT Work Orders Resolved in 72 Hours**




#### **Non-Emergency Maintenance Work Orders Resolved - 24 Hours**



#### **Teacher Attendance Rate**




## Parent Perception of Engagement with Educators for setting Education Goals for Children




#### **Student Attendance Rates**






