Using Skills Trainer


1. From the home page, www.bigideasmath.com, click on the hamburger symbol in the topright corner to show the drop down menu pictured below.




2. Click on the Skills Trainer to access extra practice problems.

4. When you select a skill to practice, here is what it might look like:




5. If you press the red "Stop" button to either get help or change the skill, you will see something like the screen below. You will also see this screen after you have answered all the questions for a skill.
