PROGRAM OVERVIEW and ELIGIBILITY

- Incoming **2nd Grade Emergent Bilingual students** in need of accelerated instruction in math and/or reading due to performing below grade level on:
 - TPRI/Tejas Lee, or
 - EOY Math Assessment
- **All incoming 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade students** are eligible; however, **priority will be given to students in need of accelerated instruction** due to performing below grade level on:
 - EOY Math Assessment, or
 - 21-22 STAAR Math and/or Reading.
- Eligibility for **incoming 6th Grade students (at middle school campus)** will be those in need of accelerated instruction due to performing below grade level on:
 - 21-22 STAAR Math, Reading, and/or Science.
- Jump STAART will be held at all elementary campuses.
- Transportation will be provided to all current eligible riders meeting the Rider Eligibility Requirements as stated by BISD Transportation.
- Breakfast and lunch will be provided for all participating students.

DESCRIPTION and PURPOSE

The purpose of the Jump STAART Program for incoming 2nd - 5th grade is to provide an opportunity for students in need of accelerated instruction.

Major focus: The focus is to provide students with accelerated instruction, work toward closing the learning gap, and an opportunity to start the school year in a positive manner.

Goal: The goal is to provide instruction in math and reading through a reinforcement of targeted TEKS. The campus administrators will work with their teachers on differentiation and small group hands-on instruction to maximize learning opportunities.

The English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS) will be used in accordance with the proficiency level of the Emergent Bilingual student (EB).

Classroom and CAMPUS VISITS

Classroom visits will be conducted by the campus administrators. At least two informal classroom visits will be conducted per teacher.

Assessment Procedures

- Incoming 2nd – 5th grade students will receive instruction in math and reading
- A pre and post assessment will be administered for math and reading to monitor growth.
- Pre/Post Math and Reading Assessments will be available for online administration.
- Scores must be documented on the Excel Jump STAART Pre/Post Assessment Documentation Form and uploaded to the 2022 Elementary Jump STAART OneDrive Campus Folder.
- Scores will also need to be submitted to ETAZO.

Campus Administrators are responsible for monitoring the number of students in each class daily to make the closure/consolidation determination. **Enrollment may not fall below 10 students per class.**

Pupil: Teacher Ratio may be adjusted as per District needs.

Teachers are not allowed to remain on campus as “floaters.”

All teachers of record must have a class roster and be included on the master schedule on eSchool.

Campus Responsibilities

Administrative Responsibilities

- Schedule all activities at their respective campuses.
- Ensure instructional materials are available to all staff.
- Implement discipline procedures in place as defined by the Student Code of Conduct.
- Implement arrival and dismissal procedures to ensure the safety of students, including effective communication for students transported to and from their home.
- Provide a schedule for staff to assist with morning and afternoon duties.
- Submit the **2022 Elementary Jump STAART Program Campus Principal Clearance List** required documents by grade level.
- Provide completed **Jump STAART Pre/Post Assessment Documentation Form** by teacher
- Attend all appropriate staff development sessions and called meetings.
 - Professional Development Dates: Thursday, July 21st and Saturday, July 23rd.
- Comply with additional/assigned duties as needed to implement an effective Jump STAART program.
- Submit the **Supplemental Duty Recommendation Form** for teachers through TalentED. Additional names may be included in case changes or substitutions need to be made. Under the “Supplemental Duty” column of the Supplemental Duty Recommendation Form, indicate alternate teachers by including “(Alt)” next to the grade level of the designated teacher(s). **Lead Teachers** can also be included in the same 3rd-5th Supplemental Duty Recommendation Form by indicating “Lead Teacher” in the Supplemental Duty column coinciding with the Employee Name.
- Fire Drill, campus lockdown and campus evacuation drill, etc.

Instructional Responsibilities

- Inform selected teachers of Jump STAART staff development dates:
Thursday, July 21st and Saturday, July 23rd.
- Implement the Jump STAART Instructional Program adhering to the Jump STAART 2022-2023 Elementary Program Handbook.
- Distribute instructional supplies, materials, and textbooks.
- Provide access to computer lab and/or technology as needed for all Jump STAART personnel and students.
- Keep record of and secure electronic devices in a secure location.
- Make available copier, supplementary instructional materials, AV equipment, district adopted curriculum, student resources and supplies.
- Conduct 2 classroom observation visits per teacher using the Informal Classroom Visit form.
- Ensure **Student Intervention End of Program Reports** are completely filled out by teachers with appropriate signatures and submitted for clearance.
- Ensure that the **2022 Elementary Jump STAART Program Eligibility Rosters** are completed and submitted for clearance.

HB4545 Responsibilities

- Students failing the Math and/or Reading STAAR in the 2021-2022 school year will require 30 hours of accelerated instruction in math and/or reading during the 2022-2023 school year.
- The following documentation needs to be monitored and kept at the campus, readily available and uploaded to the **2022 Elementary Jump STAART OneDrive Campus Folder** by the end of the Jump STAART Program
 - **2022-2023 BISD Elementary Jump STAART Reading/Math Contact Log** (kept on file at campus) uploaded to the **2022 Elementary Jump STAART OneDrive Campus** folder
 - **Student Intervention End of Program Report** (kept on file at campus) uploaded to the **2022 Elementary Jump STAART OneDrive Campus Folder**
 - **Jump STAART Attendance Sheet**, handwritten (kept on file at campus) uploaded to the **2022 Elementary Jump STAART OneDrive Campus** folder
 - **HB4545 Notification of Student Eligibility** signed by parent (kept on file at campus)
 - **Jump STAART Permission Form** (kept on file at campus)

eSchool Responsibilities

- Send electronic Attendance Sheets and Daily Enrollment Reports to the Curriculum, Instruction and Accountability department by 10:00 am on a daily basis to Roman Gomez (regomez@bisd.us) and Annette Harms (aharms@bisd.us)
- Ensure that all students are enrolled and correctly entered into eSchool Master Schedule.
- Monitor enrollment and attendance in all classrooms on a daily basis.
- Collaborate with Computer Services and Attendance departments to maximize the allotted student attendance for funding purposes.
- Distribute students accordingly as a result of a class closure to ensure student success.
- Campus Administrator will monitor attendance daily and make appropriate determinations to consolidate/close classes due to low enrollment **beginning the second day of class**. Enrollment cannot fall below 10 students per class.

Payroll Responsibilities

- Implement payroll procedures concerning personnel, budget, supplemental composite forms, and time sheets
- Monitor TimeClock Plus, weekly printouts, and correction logs as requested by the Payroll Department
- Adhere to all deadlines for submitting Jump STAART TimeClock Plus and payroll documentation
- If substitute teachers are needed, ensure their timesheets are also submitted according to this schedule

Jump STAART Teachers

TimeClock Plus documentation and composite forms will be completed by each teacher and verified by the campus administrators. These forms will be submitted according to the Jump STAART payroll deadlines included in this handbook.

Jump STAART Alternate Teachers

Teachers hired for the Jump STAART program and the class closes due to enrollment will have priority on the alternate list to substitute.

Jump STAART Alternate Teachers:

Separate TimeClock Plus documentation and composite forms with the names of alternate teachers will be handled in the same manner as a regular Jump STAART teacher. The word, “alternate” will be written next to the substitute’s name. This information will be turned in on the same day that all other Jump STAART teachers’ payroll information is due.

Only recommended teachers whose names appear in the Jump STAART Elementary Applicant List submitted through the TalentED system are eligible to work and receive compensation.

Teachers are expected to work the duration of the Jump STAART program.

Jump STAART 2022

1. We need these lists of students requiring transportation services for regular and special needs students.
2. **Make sure that principals understand that we need the lists before they check out for the summer.**
3. Bus routes will be developed for **corner stops** only.
4. Transportation Department will send letters to eligible students to let them know the bus #, Bus stop, and time for both AM and PM routes.
5. Schools will receive the list of students with their designated bus#, bus stop and pick up time and drop off time.
6. We are estimating capacity 1500 students and will adjust as we start the routes.
7. Parents will need to be at the bus stop 10 minutes before the pickup time and drop off time.
8. Student code of conduct rules will remain in effect for this program.
9. Schools need to provide any accommodations or modifications required to transport the special needs students.
10. Arrival Time at the schools will be around 8:00a.m.
11. Schools need to have an individual(s) at the transportation area to receive the students in the morning and during the dismissal time as well.
