

Minutes of the Special Meeting

The Board of Trustees Commerce ISD

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Commerce Independent School District was held on June 28, 2018, at 7:00 a.m. at the Commerce ISD Administration Building, 3315 Washington St., Commerce, Texas. President Kathleen Hooten called the meeting to order, extended a warm welcome and announced that a quorum was present. The meeting had been posted for the time and manner required by law.

Dr. Reid made a motion to employ Darcie Rochester, ACW counselor; Jenna Landry, ACW teacher; Robert Urbanski, CES teacher; Kara Wallace, CHS teacher/band director; Jason Wallace, CHS teacher/band director; Kieston Carter, CMS teacher/coach; and Kay Comer, CMS teacher. Ms. Herring seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Mr. Starks made a motion to accept the resignation of Donna Morgan, Tri County SSA diagnostician. Ms. Herring made a motion to accept the resignation. The motion carried with three voting aye and Dr. Reid abstaining.

Mr. Starks made a motion to employ Erin Barker as a teacher at Tri County SSA. Ms. Herring seconded the motion. The motion carried with three voting aye and Dr. Reid abstaining.
