Abdul Joshua Pittman is the new men's basketball coach. Pittman was a professional basketball player from 1998 - 2014, finishing that part of his career in Argentina. Pittman has been in education for seven years and has served as a high school basketball coach all those years, most recently at Winston-Salem Preparatory Academy. Pittman holds a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Sociology from UNC Asheville, and a Masters of Education in Foreign Language from Grand Canyon University. "I am extremely blessed, humbled, and excited to have to the opportunity to be named the head basketball coach at Davie County High School," said Pittman. "The school has a rich history of excelling in academics and athletics. I look forward to making a positive impact and contributing to the future success of our student athletes."

Joey Anderson is the new head baseball coach.
