

A – VISION 2030: FINANCE & INFRASTRUCTUREFINANCE

11. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve Specialized Evaluation Services (Educational, Psychological, and Speech & Language Evaluation) for student #9423630866 at a rate of \$800.00 per evaluation and a virtual eligibility meeting attendance cost of \$300.00 payable to Mountain Lakes Board of Education/Lake Drive Program at a total cost of \$2,700.00.

12. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve a contract with McCabe Environmental Services for the testing of air samples related to the Renovations and HVAC Upgrades at Selover School for an amount not to exceed \$57,685.50.
