
Still remain strong in classical education. Jobs, technology, etc are evolving so quickly but strong foundations in math, literature, communication, etc. are still critical.


Enter life after 12th grade, academically, emotionally and globally prepared to have success and more importantly contribute to the community they live

Provide non college career options like electrical, welding and many others that kids can look into



Accountability for the top down with annual performance reviews. Streamlined through grade levels with curriculum. More hands on


Reposition focus on students and their needs. Kids deserve to be heard.


Teach better communication skills, about different cultures and acceptance of people different from themselves. Teach critical thinking and creativity through different arts and music programs that don't have to be associated with sports.
