OUR STUDENTS

GRADUATE DISCIPLES

Over 500 graduates lead biblical ministries in many different settings. They teach in parishes and schools, lead Bible studies, retreats and prayer groups, social justice ministries, and more. They work with prisoners, preschoolers, the sick and the poor. Continuing enrichment is available for four-year graduates.

COURSE OF STUDY

A four-year course of study accredited by the State of Connecticut covering every book of the Bible. Students need not be Catholic to enroll. Classes meet September through May with seasonal breaks.

CBS 100 and 200 Basic Biblical Studies

Includes key books of Old and New Testaments; how to read, pray and interpret using ancient and contemporary biblical tools

CBS 300 and 400 Advanced Biblical Studies

Covers remaining books of the Bible with emphasis on reading the Bible as a unified work and deepening skills of interpretation
