Below is a brief summary of the items the Board took action on:

- The Board approved the *Physical Science McGraw Hill Inspire* textbook that has been on preview for thirty days at the District Office. The textbook will be used at Los Alamitos High School for the Physical Science classes.
- The Board approved the first reading of revised Board Policy 6144 Controversial Issues
 - The policy brought forward was inclusive of collective feedback from the Board. During discussion, the Board requested a few additional changes to the policy which will be brought forward for the second reading at our next Board meeting.
- The Board approved the adoption of Resolution 2021-2022-20 Committing 2022-23 General Fund Ending Fund Balances
 - The Board demonstrated its commitment to maintaining a prudent level of financial resources to protect against the need of reducing services due to temporary revenue shortfalls or expenditures.
- The Board approved the adoption of Retirement Resolutions
- The Board approved the new job classification and job description for Network Security Analyst
