STUDENTS – STUDENT DRESS AND GROOMING

Adoption Date: July 1978; Revised February 1982; February 13, 2018

Legal Ref: U.S. Constitution First Amendment, Fourteen Amendment

Cross Ref:

Students' dress, including clothing, shoes, accessories, and jewelry, is acceptable as long as it does not include depictions or symbols of the following:

- a) sex or sexual innuendo;
- b) lewd, vulgar, indecent, or plainly offensive speech, including profanity;
- c) violence, destruction of property, or advocating the use of force;
- d) urging violation of the law or school regulations;
- e) alcohol, drugs, or tobacco;
- f) anything which substantially or materially disrupts the school environment.

Nothing in this policy shall be interpreted to prohibit expression protected by the First Amendment of the U.S. Constitution. Students with bona fide religious objections may apply for an exemption.
